

## Western Washington Local Yarn Shop Tour – Travel Notes

### Tea Cozy, Ballard:

Thursday, May 17 is the Norwegian Independence Day Parade in Ballard and the street in front of The Tea Cozy shop, 24th Avenue NW, will be closed from 4 - 8pm that day. Parking that evening will be difficult.

### Fidalgo Artisan Yarns, Whidbey Island Shops and ferry to the Peninsula:

WSDOT is in the midst of building a roundabout on Highway 20 at Sharp's Corner, Fidalgo Island. This will affect through traffic driving onto Whidbey Island and to Anacortes.

### Fidalgo Artisan Yarn & Clothing:

The Anacortes Boat and Yacht Show is May 17<sup>th</sup>-20<sup>th</sup>. There may be extra traffic and parking issues. Note that the yarn shop entrance is now on Commercial Avenue rather than at the rear of the building.

### StillyRiver Yarns:

The shop has a parking map up on the LYS Tour page of their website: [stillyriveryarns.com/2018-lys-tour](http://stillyriveryarns.com/2018-lys-tour). There is one dedicated accessible parking spot on the west side of their building; it has a ramp that connects the parking spot with the shop's front door. Please avoid parking in the 2 spots furthest to the right in our east parking lot, as those are reserved for our neighbors in the apartment behind the shop.

### Churchmouse Yarns & Teas:

Because of construction, there will be some differences inside the downtown Seattle Colman Ferry terminal. Vehicle and pedestrian entrances should remain the same.
